B. PROCESS OF ADMISSION

It is hereby notified that the admission of students in the CDOE of MSCB University will be done online using the steps given below. ABC ID and DEB ID are mandatory for registration.

Step 1- Create ABC ID: Visit the DigiLocker website: <https://www.digilocker.gov.in/> . Sign up or log in to your DigiLocker account. Create an Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID using your Aadhar Linked Phone Number.

Step 2- Generate DEB ID: Go to the DEB portal: <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/> Click on the “Student DEB ID” link. Enter your ABC ID. Fill in the required details (if not pre-filled automatically).

Step 3-Payment

1. Course Fee:

❖ **All Two-Year Post Graduate Programmes:** ₹20,600/- for the entire programme

- **First Year:** ₹10,600/- (₹10,000 Course Fee For 1 Year + ₹600 For Application)
- **Second Year:** ₹10,000/-

❖ **Master of Library and Information Science (MLIS):** ₹10,600/- for the entire one-year programme.

- (c) Scan both the class 10th mark sheet and certificate into a single PDF file.

- (d) Scan both the class +2-mark sheet and certificate into a single PDF file.
- (e) Scan both the Graduation mark sheet and certificate into a single PDF file.

ULM Application Process:

Step 1: Apply through the ULM Google Form

Candidates seeking a free seat under the ULM scheme must first fill in the Google Form with accurate details.

The last date to submit the Google Form is 25th September 2026.

Step 2: Selection and Verification

- The submitted details will be verified.
- Eligible candidates will be shortlisted based on their graduation marks and other eligibility criteria.

Step 3: Intimation to Selected Candidates

Candidates selected for the free seats will be intimated within 30th September 2026.

Step 4: Complete Registration

Only candidates who are intimated/selected for the free seats should proceed to fill in the registration link and complete the admission process through the e-Samarth portal by 13th October 2026.

***Note:** Filling in the Google Form does not guarantee admission. Free seats will be allotted **only** to eligible candidates selected after verification and evaluation of their graduation marks.*

E. 50% FEE REDUCTION FOR DUAL-DEGREE PG PROGRAMMES

Students currently studying in the 1st or 2nd Semester of any Postgraduate programme at MSCB University or any of its affiliated colleges can avail themselves of a **50% reduction in the course fee** when enrolling in an additional eligible Postgraduate programme through the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), MSCB University.

Eligibility:

- Currently pursuing a 1st or 2nd Semester of Postgraduate and 1st to 4th Semester Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. Students.
- Enrolled at MSCB University or any of its affiliated colleges.

Application Process for 50% Fee Reduction

Step 1: Apply through the Dual-Degree Google Form

Eligible students seeking a 50% fee reduction under the Dual-Degree Scheme must first fill in the Google Form with accurate details and upload/provide the required information.

The last date to submit the Google Form is 25th September 2026.

Step 2: Verification of Eligibility

- The submitted details will be verified by the University/CDOE.
- The student's eligibility will be checked based on their current PG enrolment and other prescribed eligibility criteria.

Step 3: Intimation of Eligibility

Eligible candidates will be intimated after successful verification and approval of their application for the 50% fee reduction.

Candidates selected for the seats will be intimated within 30th September 2026.

Step 4: Complete Admission and Registration

Candidates who are found eligible for the 50% fee reduction should proceed to complete the admission and registration process for the additional eligible Postgraduate programme through the **e-Samarth portal** within the prescribed admission schedule.

***Note:** Submission of the Google Form does not automatically guarantee eligibility for the 50% fee reduction. The fee reduction will be applicable only to students who fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria and are approved under the University's Dual-Degree Scheme rules.*
